- Deliverance is a ministry unlike others, be smart, safe, and in the right place to conduct
- Hold to your core values (God is bigger, more interesting, greater is he in you, has won, etc. etc.)

Terminology:

- **Deliverance:** the action of a believer upon another person to cast out or command away one or more demonic beings.
- **Prophetic:** hearing from, and then speaking for God.
- **Demon:** a spiritual being, fallen angel
- **Possession:** a common, but faulty translation. Wrongfully implies ownership. Demons don’t own anything.
- **Demonization:** under the control of, exercised by, or influenced by one or more demons, therefore: demonized.

“The Greek verb daimonizomai may also be translated “to be demonized.” This does happen to believers, whose soul (mind, will or emotions) can be demonically harassed in many ways and with varying degrees of torment. Such attacks from demons find effect, due to intensified, wearying personal trials (2 Cor. 12:7); due to one’s being deceived (1 Tim. 4:1, 2); through one’s being broken down by lies of the Enemy (2 Cor. 10:4-6); or by one’s repeated engagement in sinful activity (Eph. 4:27).”

Demons & Demonization

- Demons can control only the aspects of one's life which are yielded (actively or passively) to them.
- An unclean spirit influences the person, who is passive to the demon's action to one extent or another. This indicates a continuing state of being harassed by demons.
- Squatters or invaders of territory which is not their own
- Hierarchy
 - Principality (KJV) or Ruler (NIV)
 - Influence large groups or territories such as countries, states, cities, and maybe even churches.
 - Administrators of demonic influence throughout a given territory.
 - Requires unity amongst believers to address.
 - Powers (KJV) or Authorities (NIV)
 - A major demonic spirit whose primary activity is to envelop a territory with the potency of a particular type of evil.
 - What is produced by this infiltration is the "feel" or "spirit" of a city or area.
 - Rulers (KJV) or Powers (NIV)
 - Middle management
 - Spiritual Wickedness in High Places (KJV) or Spiritual Forces of Evil (NIV)
 - Foot soldiers
 - Mostly the rank we deal with in personal deliverance sessions.

Aspects of Deliverance

Who is it for?

- Freedom from our enemies is for the believer, an integral part of what Jesus made available!

Methods

There are many methods of Deliverance. Many work. Some work better than others.

Be suspect of any methods that...

- are abusive in any way to those receiving ministry.
- offer hope without actual fruit of freedom.

Common methods & downfalls:

- Catholic rite – natural authority. Yelling, pressing of cross, holy water, etc.
 - Problem: not a real source of authority
 - Louder != more authority. Usually the opposite. Ex: yelling at kids
- Lists – experiential
 - Problem: Natural knowledge and experience are limited and prone to error.
- Clues – Diagnosing
 - Problem: Natural knowledge again. Deception is the nature of the enemy.
 - Example: Anger can be the outward symptom of many types of spirits, not just a spirit of anger.

Don't speak with demons

- The native language of demons is lies.
- Spending time talking to the wrong spirit.
- Any spirit's voice other than that of the Holy Spirit is a stranger's voice.

Authority

- Technically, there are no levels of authority. There are only levels of faith.
 - All authority has been given to Jesus. Matthew 28:18-30
- Disciples couldn't cast out demons. Why? Faith. Matthew 17:14-20
- Disciples sent out, told to cast out demons. Matthew 10:5-8

Spiritual darkness

- the absence of God's active presence, Who is light
 - "God is light; in him there is no darkness at all." I John 1:5
- "Be self - controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour." I Peter 5:8
- Darkness encroaches slowly.
- Our minds must only not be renewed, but also they must be disciplined to remain alert to prevent the encroachment of darkness in our lives. At some point during that encroaching process, it becomes dark enough for demonic beings to see, and then they move in.
- "Your eye is the lamp of your body. When your eyes are healthy, your whole body also is full of light. But when they are unhealthy, your body also is full of darkness. See to it, then, that the light within you is not darkness." Luke 11:34-35
- No darkness, no demons.

Ministry Principles

- Never do deliverance alone
 - Two or three prophets should speak, and the others should weigh what is said. I Corinthians 14:29
- Never Do Deliverance Without Intercessors
 - For safety of team and seekers
- Never Do Deliverance Without the Full Armor of God in Place - Ephesians 6:10-18
 - Should be a daily awareness for believers, not just while doing deliverance.
- Never Do Deliverance with an Audience
 - More people == more chance for problems, distraction, risk, etc.
- Fast and Pray - Matthew 17:21
 - Lifestyle
- Remind the Demons of the Source of Your Authority (hint: it is Jesus)
 - Not speaking with demons, but when you say something out loud and they are in the room, they will hear.
- Always Speak and Act with Confidence
- Use the Gift of Discernment (Distinguishing Between Spirits)
 - it is the ability to recognize that a spirit is present and discern the source of a spirit
- Be Gentle
 - Stop abusing the abused

Prophetic Deliverance Model

Team

- One team leader, ideally three to seven team members, one scribe (to take notes about the session and shared with the seeker. Can be existing team member), and intercessors.

Setting

- Should be comfortable, private, and in the spiritual territory of the team.
- Circle around the seeker.

Worship

- Acknowledge, magnify, and welcome God.

Establish protection

- The angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear him, and he delivers them. – Psalms 34:7
- Attacks can be minimized and even eliminated altogether by setting up a perimeter of protection
- Mindfully set up protection for each client, team member, intercessor around their...
 - Families, homes, businesses, deliverance location, etc. Whatever Holy Spirit indicates.

Command the demons

- To be still, silent, and cease all function, so that there will be no manifestations.
- Inform of source of authority
- Have at least one team member keep their eyes open the whole time.

Ask the Holy Spirit

- To help us take captive all natural thoughts and knowledge
- To speak to the team clearly
- Manifest His gifts as needed

Discern the name of the chief demon

1. If there are demons present, what is the name of the chief and ruling spirit?
2. Is there a Generational Curse Line?
3. Is there a religious spirit?

- Answers to these questions to be written and shared with the team leader.
- Looking for agreement amongst the team.

Cast the demon out

- Team leader to cast it out, using it's agreed upon functional name.
- Team members confirm that it is gone.
- Send it away, preferably not the direction of the seeker's home.

Turn on the light

- Ask the Holy Spirit to come and light up the areas where darkness previously inhabited. To heal, and comfort. Ask the team to check for areas of darkness. Discern if they are matters of wholeness, or need to be addressed via deliverance.

Wholeness

- Deliverance removes the cancer, but does not treat the wound.
- Ministries such as Sozo
- Discipleship and pastoral follow up are KEY to the success of a deliverance recipient.
